




- Includes: The increase in Total Issuance and Average Issuance per Case in October 2022 is due to Cost-of-Living Adjustment.

- Excludes: P-EBT (Pandemic School Meals Replacement and Child Care Replacement) Program benefits are not SNAP benefits and are excluded. \$0 issued, 0 families, and 0 children for this month. P-EBT families also receiving SNAP are included in families, persons, and children, but benefits issued are excluded.

- On 6/19/2023, DBME started receiving claims for replacement of stolen benefits as a result of electronic theft, known as EBT Skimming. Between 7/1/2023 and 7/31/2023, 220 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$89,136.




**Tuberculosis Control


