




- On 6/19/2023, DBME started receiving claims for replacement of stolen benefits as a result of electronic theft, known as EBT Skimming.

- EBT Skimming Monthly Preliminary Data: Between 1/1/2024 and 1/31/2024, 144 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$61,179.

- EBT Skimming Quarterly Final Data: In Q1 (October 2023 - December 2023), 1,091 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$479,249.




### Tuberculosis Control (rolling 10 year view)


